What Happened & How

Budget Recap and Staff Update: Budget was flat funded for 2015/16.

Two programs were added to CSC which were funded by grants

- Biotechnology
- Manufacturing

How will CEC sustain programs:

- Next year CSC will look at all career programs and align to labor demand, historical course enrollment, and student placement after graduation. Our mission at CEC is to prepare students for success and global economy so it is important to align career programs to the job market and labor demand. CTE is beginning to be offered at other schools which may impact CEC enrollment.

Staff updates: 6 teachers will be retiring in 2015 and all replacements have been hired.

- Communication Director will not be replaced. CEC's administrators will absorb the communication duties and the savings of the position will go into reserve for 2016/17 school year.

Two areas for growth - To address the need CEC applied for teacher leaders who focused on the two areas for growth.


- Classroom climate

- Developed UIP and promotes structures aligned to root causes and priority performance challenge. CEC is an ELE designated school. Most of the CEC staff has completed the ELA program about 5% are working on completing course.
- Noted that TCAP scores for 9th and 10th graders have been unstable
- Structure were put in place for teachers to analyze student progress data more frequently in grade teams and data teams
- SLT brainstormed PD topics.
